675/24 MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Minute 535/24 – Arun District Council (ADC) Planning Applications – EP/58/24/CLE – Cllr Mathias advised the meeting this Application had been changed from a CLE Application to an HH Application and a new closing date for comments had been set for 19th September. Cllr Mathias declared a Personal Interest in this Application as he is a neighbour to the Application property, 69 The Ridings. The Clerk had discussed this with Cllr Bowman who, understanding the plans had not changed since the committee had considered the CLE version of this Application on 22nd July did not feel this needed to be considered again. Cllr Mathias said the Application was contrary to the made East Preston Neighbourhood Plan as the materials did not match the existing property and the rear dormer was not subservient to the roof. Cllr Mathias felt the council should object to this Application on these grounds and should ask ADC to apply a Condition for landscape screening to be implemented by the applicants.

The committee AGREED unanimously to raise objections as detailed in the paragraph above. Cllr Mathias did not vote.
