Mr Sawers said the Review was fairly damning in its comments upon how the Planning Department is managed, citing low morale, high turnover of staff and silo working as major concerns. Cllr Mathias added his own concern the Review seemed to suggest the Planning Department should concentrate on how it handled major developments, leaving smaller developments – which potentially were equally harmful locally – to their devices. The committee AGREED unanimously the Clerk should write to District Cllr Bower with some questions it would like to ask ADC.
