NOTICE OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

A27 Trunk Road - near Arundel

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th September 2019, for a maximum period of 5 days, the following temporary traffic regulations will be in force on the A27 Trunk Road in the County of West Sussex, to enable urgent carriageway repairs to be carried out in safety.

Highways England Company Limited (Company no. 9346363) (a), in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby makes the following temporary notice:-

In this notice,

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip/link road joins, or the last point where an exit slip/link road leaves the carriageway;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in part 4 of Schedule 11 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

1. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 on Tuesday 10th September 2019 and on any subsequent day, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in:-

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the A27 between Crossbush Interchange (A284) and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Clapham Interchange (A280);
- b) the westbound carriageway of the A27 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Clapham Interchange (A280) and Crossbush Interchange (A284);
- c) all side roads at junction with the carriageways described in a) and b) above;
- d) all gaps and right turn facilities between and in the carriageways described in a) and b) above; and
- e) all the slip roads leading to and from the carriageways described in a) and b) above.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, during periods of up to 24 hours starting at 18:00 on Tuesday 10th September 2019 and on any subsequent day, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait, or proceed in any lay-by adjacent to the carriageways described in 1.a) and b) above.

3. The work will be conducted over two nights, one carriageway at a time, beginning with the eastbound. Traffic affected by the closures will be diverted using the A284, A259 and A280

4. The provisions of this notice shall apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, and any vehicle being driven in accordance with a direction given by a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
